A gold ring set with a sard intaglio depicting Cupid tormenting a Centaur.

Roman, 1st century BC / 1st century AD.??

The ancient intaglio measures 1.4 x 1.2 cm.??

The ring size is a O 1/2 UK / 7.2.5 US.??

The high carat gold ring is modern.

The intaglio has historical damage to the bottom, however in the classical taste the setting edge of the ring incorporates a fine gold repair.?
