Large terracotta from the end of the 19th century representing Bacchus as a child.

the god of wine appears to us here in the guise of a reclining naked putto wearing a crown of vine branches and grapes, looking at his entourage as he has just dropped a cup of wine.

the sculptor was able to render in the face of the toddler the attitude of a child who has just made something stupid and who scans around him to see the reactions.

it is a large charming terracotta and in excellent condition.

it was based on a thick plexiglass allowing better protection.

very beautiful old patina.

a beautiful terracotta or Bacchus child appears to us in the guise of a joyful and charming toddler.
