Each of the drawers of this small piece of furniture has a discreet wall-mounted entrance accompanied by an original lock in working order and a later key. The bottoms, sides and backs of these drawers are in oak. This piece of furniture with pronounced veining and a warm color has uprights with cut sides and sides in grain mahogany veneer. In the lower part, a plinth whose top is grooved rests on small plate feet. Finally, the mahogany top has a perimeter composed of a groove, a square and a small corbin's beak below. This ideal-sized weekly organizer will also charm you with its numerous storage spaces and its sober lines.
