Rare necessary kit from the First Empire period
With ivory tools in its burl wood veneer box. It contains: Two wooden and steel wire dispensers (traces of oxidation) A pair of steel scissors. A needle case A folding knife (bone and steel, small points of oxidation) A drum hook A thimble (1 cm hair) A toothpick, ear pick A salt bottle, silver cap hallmarked with "bundle of licitor", this is the hallmark used by the Paris office from 1798 to 1809. very slight sagging, barely visible on the cork. The bottle still has its interior glass cap. A steel lace needle. It is complete.
