Description

Signed in the cartridge "TAJ" = "Royal" Kashmar carpets are woven in the northeast of Iran, in the small town of Kashmar, in the province of Khorassan.

These rugs, elegant works of art, are particularly appreciated for their harmonious color combinations and their very subtle level of detail. These rugs are often very large and woven with fine, soft wool, which results in a rather thick pile that is very soft when walked on. Kashmar rugs can boast a wide range of designs: from beautifully ornate central medallions to spandrel patterns reminiscent of classic Keshan rugs, all are characteristic of the region. However, the most famous and singular pattern is the zirhaki. The Farsi word "zirhaki", which can
