Rare set of eight caned chairs in lacquered beech resting on four arched legs joined by an X. The belt is sculpted on the front and sides of a shell framed by foliage. The seat is connected to a very high back marked by a strong shoulder and sculpted in its center on the upper crosspiece with stylized foliage and a plume. The lower crosspiece of the backrest is slightly curved. The lacquer is original. Regency period Usual restorations, two cane seats to be restored H. 113 x L. 48.5 x D. 42 cm A chair close to our model is kept at the Museum of Decorative Arts.
