Description

Very beautiful and large bronze print by Léopold Steiner (1853-1899), with a nuanced brown patina, representing a bearded shepherd who carries at arm's length a Sylvain, a small protective divinity of the woods and fields. This neoclassical-inspired sculpture draws its origins from Roman mythology. Signature on the L.Steiner terrace and foundry stamp Thiébaud Frères in Paris

History : 1884: Steiner obtains a travel grant thanks to the plaster model by Berger et sylvain
1885: January 15, the State orders its creation in bronze from Eugène Gonon for 5,500 F.

1893: March 29, order of attribution to the Luxembourg Museum, placed on the terrace (inventoried LUX 117 and RF 4081).

1931: sent to the marble depot. 1931: June
