Vintage statue of a bear walking. Made from lime wood, finely carved and hand painted with naturalistic details in Brienz, Switzerland, circa 1930s. A fine example of the famous Swiss-made Black Forest wooden sculptures.

The tradition of wood carving in Brienz dates back to the mid-19th century. People in the area were looking for new job opportunities. They used their traditional craft skills, carving everyday objects and sculptures, and created a new business. Many woodcarvers were trained at the Brienz School of Woodcarving, founded in 1884. Around 1900, the woodcarving industry had around 2000 carvers. Brienz's wood sculptures have been successfully presented at several world exhibitions. With Gran Tour
