Dimensions of the canvas 27x22 cm Total dimensions, with frame, 40x35.5 cm Jeanne Besnard-Fortin, born December 3, 1892 in Dolus-le-Sec in Indre-et-Loire, died December 11, 1978 in Amboise, is an artist figurative painter. She studied in Tours then in Paris where she settled around 1917. She began exhibiting in 1927 at the Salon des Indépendants and at the Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts. She met Mane Katz (Jewish school in Paris), Clovis Trouille (surrealist, friend of Breton), Julio Gonzales, Gines Parra and Oscar Dominguez (Spanish school in Paris). The Cuban writer Ramon Vasconcellos devotes a chapter to him in his book Montparnasse, Impressions d'Art in 1938. His work is essentially composed of watercolors and gouaches including numerous nudes, landscapes of Touraine, Brittany and Provence. She hardly exhibited any more after the war. She retired and died in Touraine in 1978.
