Elegant rug in wool called "Kork" and silk made on silk, Ispahan Design, Extra Fine Quality. Around 1980.

The rugs are hand-knotted in India, modeled on Persian rugs. Hence their name Indo-Isfahan. The oriental motifs of the carpets are medallions or repetitions of motifs, but also the representation of the tree of life. The rugs are very well executed, and the silk gives them finesse and lightness, with a beautiful shiny appearance.

The use of silk also makes it possible to create very fine patterns and one can only be impressed by the work necessary to create a rug. These beautiful silk rugs give a smooth, soft texture with natural beauty and luster.
