Trained at the Académie Julian workshop, he exhibited for the first time at the Salon d'Automne in 1920, of which he became a member. It was at this time that he came under the influence of André Dunoyer de Segonzac, and painted still lifes and figures. Jacques Thévenet exhibited at the Salon des Indépendants in 1922. He met the art critic Roger Allard who presented him at Gallimard. From this meeting will be born
