Braid formed of three matte gold twists, doubling around a large-sized gold uniform button for a naval officer stamped with an anchor. The large twists on the tips indicate that this is a senior officer's bicorn. Blue satin interior of the headdress, marked in gold letters with the hatmaker's mark "Gautier Fils Toulon".
