Slightly amber translucent blown glass, the truncated conical shape cup very widely flared, entirely engraved with the wheel on three registers, the first representing a castle, the second two birds on a leafy mound holding a laurel wreath in their beak, the third a bird with bare wings pecking, all interspersed with vine branches; pellets and foliage. The leg is made up of several discs. the round foot very slightly raised with the trace of the pontil: Very good condition Height: 16.3 cm Diameter of the cup: 9.6 cm Diameter of the foot: 10 cm Work probably from the Netherlands 18th century
