Beautiful and elegant ironwork for this transom grille. It has a rounded shape at the top with a central drop giving it rhythm. It is slightly rounded, giving it volume. Beautiful decoration of large volutes ending in windings and presenting in its middle, in a circular medallion and taken in a polylobed movement, an interlaced motif. The base is straight and rests on small scrolled feet.

Good condition.

The feet were brought back later.

In the building, the transom is the independent, fixed or opening part located above a door and providing light.
