



Tortoiseshell And Gilded Brass Ball Book



Description

Ball notebook presented in a binding composed of two domed tortoiseshell plaques finely set in a frame with floral motifs pierced and finely engraved in gilded brass.

In the center of the first cover an AB monogram. Inside we find a notebook of blank sheets, which has two cardboard sheets in the middle with the days of the week printed in gold.

At the end of the notebook is a calendar decorated with fine engravings dated 1857.

The interior reverses are covered with beige moire, a gusset for reserving business cards and a refillable silver mechanical pencil (Boar hallmark).

A pin forming a hinge at the edge of the pages allowed the notebook to be replaced.
