## Description

Part of a ceramic and metal tea/coffee service, including a tea/coffee pot and a milk jug. Model created by Marcel Ramond, French designer born in 1935 in Saint-Etienne. Note, a chip on the pouring spout of each piece. Teapot height : 15 cm. Teapot base diameter : 20 cm. Milk pot height : 8.5 cm. Milk pot base diameter : 11 cm. Born in Saint-Etienne where he studied at the Technical Engineering School of Sainte Barbe then at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts of Saint-Etienne, he became a licensed architect in 1967. He met Le Corbusier in 1967, who asked him to create a 60/70 centimeter model of the future church of Firminy-Vert.
