Bronze with brown patina, depicting Napoleon Bonaparte (1769-1821), wearing his famous bicorne hat, in a standing position, his right hand in his waistcoat and the other behind his back, holding a document. Napoleon Bonaparte was the first French emperor from May 18, 1804 to April 6, 1814 and from March 20 to June 22, 1815, under the name Napoleon I. A controversial personality, he is at the origin of the transformation of France. From the creation of high schools and the baccalaureate, including the penal code, the Bank of France and the Paris stock exchange, he made France a modern country.
