In Tunis, he was a student of Ridha Bettaïeb, then worked in Parisian public workshops, including that of the Grande Chaurmière. He participates in group exhibitions, including: in 1995 at the Arab League of Paris "Arab Painting of Yesterday and Today", where he was the representative of Tunisia, in 1996 in Carthage "Painting Tunisian in France. He also presents his works in personal exhibitions including: 1995 Paris at the "Arab League" and in cultural centers.

The artist practices a traditional technique, however in certain animated scenes, the touch becomes freer and more incisive, tending towards some expressionism.
