Louis HOTTOT (1834-1905): Polychrome metal sculpture depicting Isis in bust, period around 1900. Hottot (Louis): sculptor born in 1834, died in Neuilly sur Seine in 1905 (Ec.Fr.) Member of French Artists. Orientalist characters and scenes dominate the production of this sculptor based in Paris on rue des Petites-Ecuries. It was only in 1885 that he participated for the first time in the Salon de la Société des Artistes Français Height 34 cm Weighs nearly 6 kilos Some wear to the polychromy, the general state of conservation is very good, with a beautiful original patina. In addition to her traditional role as wife, mother, healer and protector of the deceased, Isis was revered as the goddess of luck, the sea and travel. Price nonnegotiable.
