(Bains-les-Bains 1853 - Tassin-la-Demi-Lune 1916) The marsh in spring 1895 Oil on canvas 70 x 100 cm Salon de Lyon 1895, no. 54 Provenance: M. Buffaud Large, almost panoramic, painting of a landscape in the Dombes, the region of a thousand ponds between Lyon and Bresse. Léon Benoît began his career, like many Lyon artists, as a flower painter for which he had a great mastery. Gradually however his vocation as an outdoor landscape painter revealed itself and by the mid-1890s he was one of the most famous landscape painters in Lyon. This painting, exhibited at the Salon de Lyon in 1895, is a perfect example of his craft: at the same time a true landscape, conceived on the spot, and also a machine for the public Salon and the walls of the
