They are called barrots in Côte de Nuits, but also Barils, Barlots, Barris or Barricots in other regions.

These barrels simply served as a container for the drink, often wine mixed with water, which the plowman took with him for his day of work in the vineyards or fields.

This one is made of wood and wrought iron from the 19th century.

Sold in its original condition with its original patina, it is in good condition, note that a small metal circle is missing which does not harm the solidity of the whole. Monogram: M
