Émile Louis Picault (24 August 1833 - 24 August 1915) was a French sculptor, best known for works depicting allegorical and patriotic subjects, and mythological heroes. Picault was a very

prolific artist, producing sculptures in abundance--over 500 models in total--during his long sculpting career. He began to show his artwork at the Salon beginning in 1863. He signed the majority of his work as "E. Picault".
