France The Sarreguemines manufactory, founded in 1790 in Lorraine, is a famous French faience factory that played a major role in the European ceramics industry. Combining artisanal tradition with technical innovation, it produced a wide variety of pieces, ranging from utilitarian tableware to decorative objects. In the 19th century, the manufactory specialized in fine faience, porcelain, and mass-produced decorative items often adorned with floral, geometric, or naturalistic motifs. Sarreguemines is known for its innovative decorating techniques, such as polychrome glazing and lithographic printing on ceramics. The pieces reflect the artistic styles of the 19th century, from Neoclassicism to Art Nouveau, with great attention to detail and
