Dien Silver Medal Revised in 1849, in Paris at Ch. Dien, Rue des Beaux Arts n°8", mid-19th century, around 1850. Beautiful scientific instrument, typical of the layout of a man's office at the beginning of the 19th century. Good general condition, the cardboard is uniformly yellowed, some cracks on the cardboard which add to the charm of this beautiful object of great decoration.
