### Description

Gilded bronze edition of the "Baigneuse au chat" after the sculpted marble work of Albert Ernest Carrier-Belleuse. Statuette marketed around 1920 by La Galerie Arthur Goldscheider which was located at 28 avenue de l'Opéra in Paris. Very good general condition, brown/beige veined onyx stone base not included in the height indicated, (total height: 30 cm). On the base of the bronze is the Carrier-Belleuse signature, the founder's AG Paris stamp as well as a numbered monogram. Arriving in Paris around the age of 13, Albert Ernest Carrier-Belleuse learned carving then goldsmithing; it was the sculptor David D'Angers who facilitated his entry into the School of Fine Arts in 1840. A brilliant student, he will be asked to join the biggest publishing houses. He exhibited at the Salon from 1857, Emperor
