



Small "all Faces" Furniture In Mahogany, Louis XVI Period - Late 18th Century



Description

This solid mahogany piece of furniture opens on the front with a sliding opening, called a "curtain", equipped with a lens button. The uprights, slightly rounded, are profiled by pointed-shaped parts with high and low flanges. This small piece of furniture offers a slightly concave spacer shelf on the front, recessed on the sides and back, with reserve strips. These elements rest on cylindrical top and spindle legs. The top of this property has a pretty recessed turquin blue marble. Occasional or bedside furniture, this small Louis XVI period piece of furniture, which can be placed in the middle of a room, will easily find its use in your home. ******* Period: Late 18th Century Excellent condition.
