Very beautiful scene executed with virtuosity where the skillfully treated light reveals the musculature and power of the horses in their race, leaving the background in a slight blur to give depth, thus accentuating the impression of speed.

Biography:

Eugène Péchaubès was born in 1890 in Pantin and died in 1967 in Paris. He first distinguished himself as a painter of military subjects then he tended to devote himself almost exclusively to the study of racing horses to the point of becoming a true horse portraitist.
