were Cottavoz, Fusaro, P. Coquet, H. Mouriquand and Philibert-Charrin. In 1947, he went to Paris and drew at La Grande Chaumière. That same year, he exhibited at the first "salon for those under thirty" alongside André Cottavoz and Bernard Buffet. Back in Lyon, in 1948 he founded the "Sansiste" group with his Beaux-Arts accomplices, which exhibited the chapel of the Ampère high school.
