The white marble vases, baluster-shaped, have two twisted handles in gilded bronze. The whole rests on a gilded bronze pedestal decorated with laurel leaves, and a square white marble base with a frieze of rows of pearls. Condition: welding on one arm and two handles. A broken brass strip on a base. This type of candelabra in the shape of a vase garnished with branches and flowers is characteristic of the Louis XVI taste, marked by the return to nature.
