- Orion pocket or pocket watch in solid silver decorated with a coat of arms in the center of the bowl with barley grain guilloché work. - German hallmark 800/1000 (crown and moon) and Swiss title grouse and the number 0.800 in a rectangle present on the bowl and the dust cover and goldsmith with the letters BHnumber 52583, case hallmarked grouse. - Dust cover marked ORION in a rectangle with different awards obtained in the form of a medallion and the mention precision anchor watch, A.Fondair Rémy Namur engraved in hollow. -Smooth edge of the watch and bezel, curved and beveled mineral glass. - White enamel dial marked in black A.Fondair Rémy Namur, Roman numerals for the hours and Arabic for the minutes railroad minute graduation, black metal hands and second hand at six o'clock. -

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Movement numbered 64605 in gilded brass jeweled with rubies with anchor escapement, crown and winding wheel in polished steel, advance and delay racket. - Pendant winder and set the time by pressing the small push button by pressing to the left on the edge next to the stem of the bail, turning the winder at the same time clockwise. - In perfect working order, serviced by a watchmaker. - Late 19th century period around 1890-1900. - Gross weight: 85.59 gr.
