Bicorné of a marine non-commissioned officer. - bicorne in black felt, highlighted with a large woven silk braid, representing a course of naval anchors inscribed in a garland of oak leaves, Tricolor cockade sewn at the front, black piped braid braid in the center and gold, maintained in the lower part by a golden uniform button stamped with a naval anchor for officers, Interior of headdress in blue satin, marked in gold with the hatter's mark "Tudor lamber port de toulon".
