Console, half-moon shaped server with rounded sides in mahogany and mahogany veneer, opening on the front with a drawer, with mahogany crotch shelf (slot), resting on 4 fluted spindle legs, gray marble top surrounded by a gallery openwork bronze This elegant and classic console is presented in its "juice", possibility of restoring it in our workshop on estimate, it is stamped by Nicolas Petit maitre in 1761, he very quickly became well known for the quality of his work with refined furniture, often with simple and classic decors, his creations are always in good taste and made with care. The console presented here is a good example.
