Through a play of colors: pinks, blues and whites, the touches intertwine and blend together for a superb impression of the hand of Charles Malfroy, the painter who built his reputation on his representations of Martigues and Venice.(Italia)

Born in Lyon on May 27, 1862 and died in Kremlin-Bicêtre on July 21, 1939, his work is in the post-impressionist lineage of Jean-Baptiste Olive.

If Charles Malfroy's reputation suffers from his plethoric production, we also know that he was an excellent painter and this work of great sincerity attests to it. His interpretation of the "Martigues" old port at sunset, exudes beautiful depth and
