The body with the CL monogram with intersecting laurel branches from the Charles X period (around 1820). The interest of this piece is its presence in the beautiful color of the polished red copper and in very good condition (not dented) and its beautiful cartouche (probably a rich wedding gift from the alliance of two Families. The hat with double pinnacles of bronze like the two beautiful faucets. The flight of the basin is grandiose and very elegant and the body of the fountain with its beautiful movement is not unworthy. An unscathed piece that has reached us, miraculously spared from any interest decorative for an entrance, a veranda where you want to give a note of light and color to a wall
