Description

18th-19th century bracelet in 18-carat yellow gold and silver adorned with 75 rose-cut diamonds, mounted on foil (The underside of the stone is enclosed in a closed setting, and rests on a fine silver leaf. This gives it more sparkle. The underside of the stone is not accessible, because it has a closed back) and in a closed setting whose total weight is estimated at approximately 35 carats of cut diamonds rose including 3 diamonds of 1 carat each in the center of the bracelet. Each rose cut diamond is surrounded by a pavé of 8/8 cut diamonds. Ratchet clasp with two safety eights. Condition: very light micro scratches and oxidation on the gold and silver parts, chips and cracks on the diamonds.
