Description

Beautiful set of Oils on canvas depicting two scenes from Spanish rural life in the 19th century. The first painting represents two men in the shade of a building, discussing, accompanied by their horses. A dog and a child are added to this scene. In the background, a smoking lime kiln and the entrance to a town in the distance appear. This episode of Hispanic life is intriguing due to the arrangement of its characters. Indeed, the central figure highlights the two horses eating fodder. The second painting shows a woman and a man traveling with their animals. The woman, reminiscent of Mary, stands sidesaddle on a brown horse. She looks down lost in thought. Her companion, a shepherd's staff placed on her shoulder, watches over her. Accompanied by cows, a chicken, a horse and sheep, they leave the

city whose ramparts appear in the distance. The painter carefully describes the different protagonists, their gestures and their clothing with attention. Surrounding the canvases, magnificent frames carved in gilded wood match perfectly with these painted scenes.
