

A PENDANT known as a Fanaga, halfway between a representation of a SERPENT probably a python - and a CAIMAN, as described by Bertrand Goy in his book Bronzes gan, La spirale du serpent, holds a fish in its mouth. Gan culture, Burkina Faso 19th century Copper alloy; H.: 17.4; L.: 4.2 cm
