Without any maintenance apart from regular washing.

No need for wax or protective product.

The hardness of the stone is sufficient to protect it from the risk of stains, oil, wine, etc.

Ideal for underfloor heating.

Lot provided for installation in Roman Opus Possibility of retrenchment at 3 cm thickness in order to facilitate implementation and keep only the upper crust marked by 3 or 4 centuries of our history.
