

Faux Rosewood Painted Tin Coffee Grinder, Japy, Circa 1900, Superb Condition



Description

Pretty cube grinder, lacquered tin, black lacquered interior, exterior like precious faux wood. It opens like a "snuff box", by tilting mill on its hinged box base. Sides of cube are fluted, like half-dome on top, which also opens with hinged mouth for loading grains. Mechanics are from Japy, famous on period for its quality. "Japy: See Fonteneilles Factory period of Japy on last photo. From watch movements, Japy moved on to clocks and diversified into tools, motors, bicycle parts, lighting, garden furniture, pumps, coffee grinders, typewriters, etc. The 1880s marked Japy's golden age. Nearly 5,000 workers work in Japy factories in Beaucourt region. » This mill existed in 7 sizes, ours: 8.5cm cube, weight: 400g.
