The play Chantecler was performed for the first time on February 7, 1910 at the Théâtre de la Porte Saint Martin in Paris. "Over a farmyard reigns a rooster, Chantecler, so convinced of his importance that he imagines, through his crowing, making the sun rise." Origin from "Au Nain Bleu" store. The story of Le Nain Bleu began in Paris in 1836. First established at 27 boulevard des Capucines, Au Nain Bleu quickly established itself as a reference in the world of toys.
