Enamelled terracotta sculpture from Bavent potteries representing a pig. Good condition, note a small chip at the right corner of the nose. The Mesnil de Bavent pottery is located between Cabourg and Caen in Normandy. The specialty of this company, created in 1842 as the Norman tile factory, is the ridge spike, a common decoration in Normandy. But the manufacturing is also focused on other roof and garden decorations, animals including also smaller decorative ones. .
