It is This is a representation of the outraged Christ holding a branch in his right hand, certainly referring to the humiliation of Christ when the Roman soldiers wove a crown of thorns which they placed on his head and placed a reed in his head. right hand; then kneeling before Jesus, mocking him, saying: Hail, king of the Jews! (Matthew 27/29).

The reed that was given to Jesus represents the scepter and they adorned him with a crown of thorn (scepter and crown, two symbols of royalty) the symbolism of our painting is further

It seems to appear a letter or a monogram at the
bottom left, on the block of stone supporting the
column Note quite numerous small jumps in
pigments and small deformations and the
