Description

Pretty pocket snuffbox in shape of a travel chest, enameled from beautiful blue, which at period was called here "barbeau", that of the wildflower, Parisian silver setting, bearing small objects of Paris hallmark, 1750/1756, full Louis XV. Shape of chest and enamel technique are typical of the Fromery workshops, former French Huguenots who made a career in Berlin, recognizable by the technique of the wheel passed over the base enamel before firing, which then serves as a support for the final gilding over low heat. See in the photos, it's superb, Color and condition.
