The silvered bronze sculpture represents a boy who mows wheat using a scythe. The boy is dressed in a headband and wears a straw hat on his head. At its feet, you can see ears of corn growing. The sculpture is executed with finesse and great attention to detail.

Eugène Laurent (1832 - 1898) - French sculptor born in 1832 in Gray. Between 1861 and 1893, he presented his works several times during exhibitions in Paris. Known for his works on classical and realistic subjects. He is the author of monuments such as: Jacques Callot in Nancy and François Boucher at the Paris City Hall.
