## Description

Mirror in gilded wood surmounted by a pediment representing a trophy composed of a helmet, an arrow and a lictor's bundle framed by laurel branches. The mirror frame is carved with rows of pearls and is molded around its perimeter. At the four corners, the mirror is decorated with a flower. The lower part is carved with oak leaves framed by two pine cones. Louis XVI period Usual restorations, chips to the gilding H. 152 x L. 80 cm
