Le Breton by Jean Georges ACHARD sculptor from Bordeaux, terracotta from a unique workshop copy signed lower left. Jean-Georges Achard, born March 13, 1871 in Abzac and died September 23, 1934 in Bordeaux, is a French sculptor and designer. A student of his father Jean-Achille Achardet de Falguière, Jean-Georges Achard exhibited at the French Artists from 1891 and received a 3rd class medal in 1903 and then the silver medal in 1922. He lives and works in Montparnasse, at 14 avenue du Maine, then at 11 impasse Ronsin, at 32 rue Dutot and at 18 rue Antoine Bourdelle.
