



Scepter In Rock Crystal, Silver And Gilded Metal, 20th Century



Description

This small scepter is a rare object of curiosity from Tibet. The vajra - the element forming the end surmounting the silver sheath - meaning "diamond" and "lightning", is an important symbol and a ritual instrument in Hinduism and especially in the Vajrayana Buddhist tradition ("way of the diamond") to which he gave his name, as well as in the bön (three distinct Tibetan religious traditions).

The Makara, the dragon-headed creature, is an aquatic animal from the mythological bestiary of India. He has an elephant's trunk, crocodile teeth and a fish's tail. This creature is associated with fertility and is found in different forms in India and Southeast Asia. This item has been lightly
