TORFAN pendant with TWENTY-SIX HEADS Gan culture, Burkina Faso 19th century Copper alloy H. 38 ; L 15.2 cm

Twenty-six-headed snake in copper alloy with a sinuous body punctuated by twisted lines referring to the reptile's scales. The twenty-six radiating heads are arranged around a disc incised with concentric circles. A suspension ring is set into the smooth reverse.

The Torfan is a spiritual entity. He manifests himself in the form of a snake which, depending on the representation, may have from one to ten heads. This divination could only be preserved by
