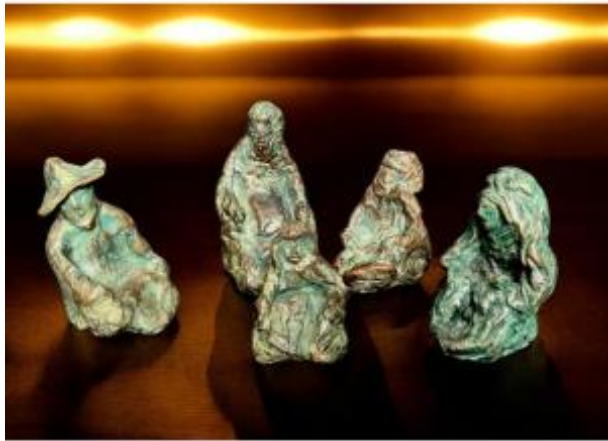




Kyna De Schouël, Five Small North African Bronzes Numbered 20th Century

A set of five small bronzes with green patina depicting characters from North Africa, some of whom are named like the Grand Vizier, the Arab. Each bronze bears the Kyna signature in hollow and is numbered out of 8 (Article 98 A of the General Tax Code: "Are considered works of art [...] sculpture casts with a limited edition of eight copies [...]". This regulation means therefore a sculpture obtained by foundry is considered an original work of art as long as it is produced in a limited edition of 8 copies maximum). Period: 20th century Height from 7 to 11 cm, total weight 3.5 kg Very good condition Kyna de Schouël (1939 -2024), French artist who lives and works in Cholet. Figurative and abstract art. Composition and decomposition of personal journeys, taste for the foreign and mystery. She
