II° EMPIRE, Large pin dagger revolver patented "DUMONTIER" and signed on the barrel band: LEPAGE. Weapon built on the basis of a Lefaucheux type revolver in caliber 12 mm with pin on which a barrel was machined and the lower part of which was machined in the shape of a large dagger with a long BOWIE type edge of 27 cm and 3 cm high. Open frame carcass bearing foliage engravings. Barrel with sides 14.5 cm long machined from a single piece surmounting this long and solid blade suitable for thrusting and cutting. Upper barrel band engraved "LEPAGE à Liege". Marking on the building side: "BREVETE DUMONTHIER- SGDG" and a number. Trigger guard with finger rest. Blackened wooden stock plate and metal cap with ring for the wrist strap. Single action mechanism
